In Bangui a very young movement

The coronavirus pandemic has disrupted all the programs that had been implemented in the movement. It has worsened the situation of retirees already weakened by the food and health situation, poverty and age.

Our movement is still very young, it is the youngest of all the movements of the Republic. He experiences a lot of difficulty in his development.

Meetings are organized today with parish teams, pastoral care for our sick brothers. With our chaplain we organize recollections (formation on the faith). We also celebrated October 1st, Senior Citizens Day, but due to lack of budget no other project was considered.

Regarding the theme of the international meeting “Reborn or Synodal Church” it is one of the major challenges of the recognition of the equal dignity of all the baptized to become subjects and bearers of the mission which is the deep nature of the Church and synodality is the path.

This exit involves the conversion of mentalities, minds and hearts. It appears as a vibrant call from the Lord to walk together, strong and weak. This is a difficulty for the movement in the Central African Republic which unfortunately was not able to participate in this meeting.
